

Mega Power Flash Drawing Promotion Rules and Regulations

Drawing Date

One (1) drawing will be conducted by the North Carolina Education Lottery ("NCEL") for qualifying "Mega Millions" and "Powerball" draw game tickets entered in the Flash Drawing Promotion ("Promotion") during the applicable Promotion Entry Period. The tentative drawing schedule for the Promotion is as follows:

The drawing dates and entry deadlines are subject to change at the sole discretion of the NCEL. Any changes will be announced by the NCEL at least seven (7) calendar days prior to the scheduled entry deadline date via the NCEL's official website (www.nclottery.com) and the information may also be obtained by calling the Customer Support Center at (866) 934-0289.

Winner

One (1) Mega Power Flash Second Chance Winner (the "Prizewinner") will be selected in one (1) second chance drawing to win \$25,000. The NCEL reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to substitute any prize with an alternate prize of equal or greater value.

Entry Eligibility Requirements

A valid entry shall follow the entry requirements herein and require a qualifying Mega Millions or Powerball draw game ticket, retail or Online Play, meeting the validation requirements of the NCEL. Entrants will receive one entry per qualifying ticket upon completing entry requirements.

1. Players may only enter the drawing by accessing the NCEL's Lucke-Rewards website at www.nclottery.com, entering the required player information and the twenty-five (25)-digit numeric entry number (Lucke-Rewards Entry Code) from eligible "Mega Millions" and "Powerball" Draw Game Tickets. Players may also enter the drawing by using the NCEL's NC Lottery Official Mobile App to scan the Lucke-Rewards barcode. Players will also earn an entry automatically when making eligible "Mega Millions" and "Powerball" Draw Game purchase in Online Play during the Promotion Entry Period.
 - The NCEL and its vendor(s) will not be responsible for data entry errors by entrants nor for connectivity issues involving the player's access to the NCEL's website or the Mobile App.

- An attempt to electronically submit an entry that has already been submitted will generate an error message informing the player that the entry has already been submitted and may not be resubmitted.
2. Entrants must be at least eighteen (18) years old to participate in this Promotion.
 3. Entrants are subject to all NCEL Rules and Regulations, the North Carolina State Lottery Act, NCEL Terms of Service and Use, and the drawing procedures for the Mega Power Flash Second Chance Drawing Promotion and any applicable laws affecting this Promotion outside the State of North Carolina. This Promotion and/or any parts thereof, including the award of any prizes, is void where prohibited by laws outside the State of North Carolina.
 4. Employees of the North Carolina Education Lottery, NeoPollard Interactive (NPi), Scientific Games Corporation (“SGP”), IGT Global Solutions Corporation (“IGT”), Spurrier Group, MDI Entertainment, LLC (“MDI”), and Thomas & Gibbs CPAs PLLC are prohibited from participating in this Second Chance Drawing Promotion. This prohibition shall also apply to any employees of companies that are associated with the game development and/or drawing process in any way.

The Internet and Mobile App entry methods are the only methods of entry into this Second Chance Drawing Promotion. Entries sent via any other method, US mail/courier, drop-off, etc., will be disqualified.

5. The date for the one (1) drawing (Drawing #1) will be announced via the NCEL’s official website (www.nclottery.com) or may be obtained through the Customer Support Center at 866-934-0289 at least seven (7) calendar days prior to the specified entry deadline date(s).
6. Entries received after the drawing entry deadline, as announced by the NCEL, shall be deemed ineligible for the Mega Power Flash Second Chance Drawing Promotion and shall be destroyed, along with non-selected entries, per the NCEL’s Records Retention Policy.
7. Players may submit more than one (1) entry in the drawing. Prize winners are not eligible to win another Prize in this Second Chance Drawing Promotion.
8. Tickets determined to be in a stolen/missing inventory status or not part of a valid sold, activated or promotional NCEL inventory status will be disqualified.
9. Tickets for Mega Millions and Powerball draw games will continue to be sold after the drawing.

Claiming Requirements

1. The prize for this second chance drawing promotion is not transferable or assignable unless otherwise specified or required by law.
2. All drawing entries are subject to validation by the NCEL and may be disqualified if eligibility requirements are not met.
3. Second Chance Drawing Prize Winners: The Prize Winners of this second chance drawing promotion must complete a Winner Claim Form at the NCEL Headquarters within thirty (30) days from the first notification date by the NCEL. If all reasonable efforts to locate the winners fail within the thirty (30) calendar day period, the NCEL will select a replacement winner from the drawing alternates. The Second Chance Drawing Prize Winners are subject to minimum Federal and State taxes and other State withholdings, as required by law. The NCEL will issue the W-2G form to the Second Chance Drawing Prize Winners for prizes above \$599.

Except where prohibited by law, acceptance of a prize constitutes Prize Winner's permission for the NCEL to use Prize Winner's name, photograph, likeness, voice, biographical information, statements and address (city and state) for advertising and/or publicity purposes worldwide and in all forms of media now known or hereafter developed, in perpetuity, without further compensation.
